- Applicants for TA or RA fellowships should have qualified UGC-NET or GATE or CSIR-NET or have MPhil degree. The Fellowship/Stipend will be applicable as per Government norms.
- SW (Sponsored WITHOUT Institute scholarship): Sponsored from a reputed Industrial or Research organization. (Full time / Part time)
- IS: Institute staff (part time) WITHOUT any scholarship from the Institute.
- DF: Serving personnel in the defence forces WITHOUT any scholarship from the Institute.

- Masters degree in Arts/Commerce/Management with a minimum of 55% marks or equivalent with UGC-NET or UGC-JRF qualification OR
- Masters degree in Science/Engineering with a minimum CPI of 6.5 or 60% marks with CSIR-NET or GATE qualification OR
- MPhil degree with a minimum of 60% marks or equivalent OR
- BTech from an Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) with a minimum CPI of 8
