## **How to reach IIT Indore**

IIT Indore is located in Simrol on the Indore–Khandwa Road at a distance of 35 km from the Airport, 27 km from the Indore Railway Station and 22 km from the Navlakha bus stand. The destination can be reached by 'City Buses' (regularly plying at an interval of 30 minutes) from Bhawarkuan Square; or, you may hire a cab/ taxi. A route map has been attached for your reference.

### Terms and Conditions for Admission to the B.Tech. Program

1. The admission is provisional and subject to the production and verification of all original certificates and documents (as mentioned in your application) at the time of registration on July 24, 2019 (Wednesday). The Institute reserves the right to withdraw the offer of provisional admission at any stage in case a candidate is not able to produce the original certificates/documents.
2. Details of financial support:
  - i. The most economically backward students (whose family income is less than Rs.1 lakh per annum) shall receive full remission of the tuition fee after admission (against the production of documentary evidence).
  - ii. The other economically backward students (whose family income is between Rs. 1 lakh to Rs. 5 lakhs per annum) shall receive remission of 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of the tuition fee after admission (against the production of documentary evidence).
  - iii. Please note that documentary evidence refers to either the Income Tax returns filed (FY 2018-19) by the parents or the Income Certificate for total parental income (FY 2018-19) issued by local district authorities such as SDO, BDO, MRO, Tahasildar, Anchal Officer, Chairman/ Executive Officer of Municipal corporation, etc.

### 3. Faculty Advisor

All students admitted to B.Tech. are assigned to a Faculty Advisor. New entrants are expected to acquaint themselves with their Faculty Advisor soon after arrival. Parents/ Guardians of students are also expected to meet and maintain regular contact with the Faculty Advisor. A meeting of students and their parents with the Faculty Advisor will be held at **17:00 hrs. on July 24, 2019.**

### 4. Compulsory Vaccination

When you come to IIT Indore, you will be staying at a Hall of Residence, in close proximity to many other students. Such environments pose a risk of the spread of various infectious diseases such as mumps, measles, chickenpox, etc. As a result, it is compulsory that all students be vaccinated against these diseases, and others, as listed below:

- Typhoid
- Hepatitis A
- MMR (one dose is essential after 15 years of age).
- Chickenpox (if there is no history of chickenpox in the past).

It is mandatory that you are vaccinated before you come to IIT and produce the vaccination certificates to the authorities upon arrival (please refer to the Medical Fitness Form available on the Institute website).

The vaccination requirement is both for your protection and the protection of other students. Please remember that your registration formalities may be put on hold if vaccination requirements are not met.

5. **Scholarship**

Merit-Cum-Means, free messing and other scholarships are available for award to the students as per Institute/ Government norms. You are advised to go through the terms and conditions available in the fee notice.

6. Please bring this offer letter in the original at the time of registration.
7. All students are required to abide by the Safety and Security rules, Internet usage rules, Dining rules, Anti-ragging rules, Hall of Residence rules, etc. of the Institute prescribed from time to time.
8. If you do not register **latest by July 24, 2019**, your admission offer will be automatically withdrawn, and no communication will be entertained or sent in this regard.
