

Hostel Reporting & Accommodation Instructions for Newly Admitted Students (AY 2026–27)

The following instructions are issued for the convenience of newly admitted students and their accompanying parents/guardians during the reporting and admission process.

1. Hostel Reporting

Students are required to report to their respective hostels based on their academic programme as detailed below:

Note: Students whose reporting hostel is mentioned as **PM Ajay Hostel / BH-07 Hostel** or **DA Hostel / DAE Hostel** are requested to first report at the **Institute Security Gate**, where they will be informed of their allotted hostel.

2. Dining Facility

The Institute dining facility, **Kshitij Mandapam**, will remain operational during the admission period.

- **Newly admitted students** may avail the dining facility **from the date of registration** using their **Mess Card**.
- **Accompanying parents/guardians** may avail the dining facility **on a payment basis**.

3. Accommodation for Parents/Guardians

Due to the large number of students reporting for admission, **accommodation for parents/guardians will not be available**.

For the convenience of accompanying parents/guardians, the Institute has arranged **designated areas in one of the hostel units for freshening up and short-term use** during the reporting process.

4. General Instructions

- Hostel staff and student volunteers will be available at the hostels to assist students during the reporting process.
- Students are advised to follow the instructions of the hostel staff and volunteers for a smooth check-in process.
- For any assistance related to hostel reporting or accommodation, please contact the **Hostel Coordination Unit (HCU)**.
- **Essential hostel and daily-use items**, such as **mattresses, buckets, pillows, bed sheets, locks, toiletries, and other necessities**, can be purchased from the **temporary pop-up stall** set up during the admission period, as well as from the **existing outlets on the campus**, for the convenience of newly admitted students.
